

## Good Shepherd Middle School - Student Supplies 2017-2018

**SPECIAL NOTE:** We would prefer no large zip binders/ trapper keepers. There are supplies for classes listed and we would like to keep it simple with just those supplies instead of the bulky and heavy binders. Thank you for your understanding.

Also, students should plan to keep a folder filled with notebook paper, their homework folder, student planner, and pencil pouch (with 6 pencils, 1 sharpie, 2 checking pens, 2 black ink pens, colored pencils, markers, highlighters, large eraser, pencil sharpener, and a glue stick) with them at all times

### Incoming 6<sup>th</sup> Grade Students:

- All students entering 6<sup>th</sup> grade must have on file in school office by first day of school: documentation of 6<sup>th</sup> grade physical exam and updated immunization information.

### For All Middle School Students:

- One book of stamps (requested by PTO)
- 1 bottle Hand Sanitizer
- 1 package *Clorox* wipes (generic ok)
- 2 boxes of tissues
- 1 roll of paper towels
- 1 package chisel or broad tip low-odor dry erase markers to be left in the homeroom
- Loose-leaf paper (at least 4 packs, keep at home and refill binder/ folder as needed)
- 4 folders (plastic tend to last longer)- 1 filled with notebook paper that goes to every class, 1 for homework, 1 for Computer Class, and 1 for Spanish
- 2 dozen #2 pencils with erasers (should always have 6 in pencil pouch & 4 for math)
- 2 black *Sharpies*
- Checking pens- red, green, or purple
- Black ink pen
- Package of colored pencils
- Package of markers
- Highlighters
- Large eraser
- Enclosed pencil sharpener
- Glue sticks
- A pencil pouch/ box
- ANSI approved Safety Goggles (do not need new ones if already have in lab)
- 2 1-subject Spiral notebooks- 1 for Science and 1 for Social Studies
- Small 3-hole pencil pouch with 4 pencils, checking pen, 2 fine tip dry erase markers, and calculator to be kept inside the math binder
- TI30-x-lls Scientific Calculator or equivalent that has same functions- you should be able to find for under \$15. This is the one I show the students how to use.
- 2 fine tip dry erase markers
- 1" 3-ring binder with loose leaf paper for math- not part of a big binder
- iPad (Air, Mini 4, or Pro or newer) with protective case
- Headphones/earbuds to use with iPad
- USB flash drive
- A GSCS Student Planner- purchase from school on orientation day- cost will be \$10

### Spanish:

- composition notebook, folder, 2 dry erase markers

### Mrs. Robson's Algebra Students ONLY:

- Composition notebook of graph paper
- 8 AAA batteries
