An Important Reminder about Attendance Policies:

After Spring Break, we will begin the practice of calling parents if a student is absent and we have not received an email or a call in the office about it by 8:00am that morning. Emails should be sent to Miss Sims (ssims@gssfrankfort.org) or you can phone the office at 502-223-5041. Regular attendance and punctuality are very important to student success and we appreciate your cooperation in these matters. Our complete attendance policy can be found in the student-parent handbook at our website <https://www.gssfrankfort.org/policies>

All students should arrive by 7:30am to be prepared for the day. All students who arrive after 7:30 a.m. are reported as tardy. Students who arrive late must be signed in by a parent at the school office.

If a child will be absent, a parent/guardian should notify the school (via phone call or email to the office) before 8:00 A.M. In cases of pro-longed absence, a doctor's certificate may be required upon the return of the student to school. After absences totaling 10 days, a doctor's statement is always required. Absence due to vacation is an unexcused absence. After 20 days of absence during a school year a student may be retained at his/her grade level.

A written or email excuse is required after any day of absence from school. The excuse needs to be signed/emailed by a parent/guardian and include the date and the reason for the absence. After 10 absences, a doctor's note is required to be excused. Excuse notes should be turned in at the office.

Important Notice Regarding 2017 Tax Statements for PK Tuition, PK Aftercare, and K-8 Aftercare: Parents may obtain Tax Statements for Calendar Year 2017 via your Facts Tuition Management Account. Instructions for generating a child care payment report from your FACTS account are as follows:

1. Log in to your FACTS account (online.factsmgt.com).
- a. If you have forgotten your password click on the "Forgot Password" option.
- b. If you don't remember the email address you used for your account, email jmckenna@gssfrankfort.org.
- c. Click on "View Details" in the block with "Payment Plan and Billing".
- d. Select the "Payments" tab under "Activity Detail".
- e. Click on the "View Printable Payment Summary" to the right, in blue.
- f. Change the "Select a year or date range" option to the appropriate year or date range you need.
- g. A report will generate detailing all payments you have made in the selected date range or year, broken out by school year.
- h. The school address and tax ID will print on the report.
- i. Select "Print" to print your report.
