

The Good Shepherd Finance Council is pleased to report to that GSS is in sound financial condition. As you can see from the accompanying statement, the school is on track to exceed income projections and meet expenses; however, this situation comes with an important clarification — the grants, donations and gifts include receipt of federal funds from programs created during the COVID-19 pandemic. The school is using these funds for academic and physical enhancements, particularly in the now 5-star rated preschool academy and to address the learning loss that occurred during the suspension of in-person school attendance. The Finance Council will continue to monitor planned expenses to ensure they are sustainable when pandemic-related receipts end. The Finance Council recognizes and applauds the school's administrative management of the finances.

Please note, the best way to ensure GSS maintains long-term, sound financial solvency is a growing enrollment in all grade levels, Pre-K through 8. A growing enrollment also lessens the need to increase tuition. GSS graduates excel after transitioning to high school due in large part to the quality of the education and the social and personal responsibility gained through the school experience. All GSS parents can assist this long-term goal by spreading the word to other prospective parents about the quality education afforded our students.


